The Montgomery High School Alumni Foundation (MHSAF) is proud to support the next generation of Montgomery High School alumni by offering up to three \$1000 scholarships and one \$2,500 scholarship to graduating seniors who embody the true Viking spirit. These scholarships are designed to support students who are continuing their education at a college, university, community college, vocational, trade, or technical school in the Fall.

Purpose and Criteria

The MHSAF Scholarship celebrates students who work hard in every aspect of their life — those who put in the effort, take responsibility whether in school or personal circumstances, and are ambitious to further their educational goals. We're looking for students who demonstrate:

- Commitment to learning and personal growth
- Leadership and initiative in all aspects of their life
- Meaningful community involvement through volunteerism, service, or work
- Character and compassion that reflect the values of the Viking community

As proud alumni, we want to recognize those students who have shown dedication, leadership and pride at Montgomery High School and beyond. This scholarship represents more than academics — it's about heart, effort, and community spirit. Whether you've led by example, volunteered your time, or supported others in meaningful ways, we want to hear your story. The MHSAF is excited to support the next generation of Montgomery High School alumni who are ready to make their mark on the world.

Minimum Requirements

- GPA: A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- Involvement: Participation in a club, athletics, leadership, job, campus beautification, religious group or other activities that support school, family or community.
- Educational Plans: Intention and confirmation applicant plans to attend a college, university, community college, vocational, or trade school as a full-time student in the Fall following graduation.
- Scholarship funding to be used to support education expenses.

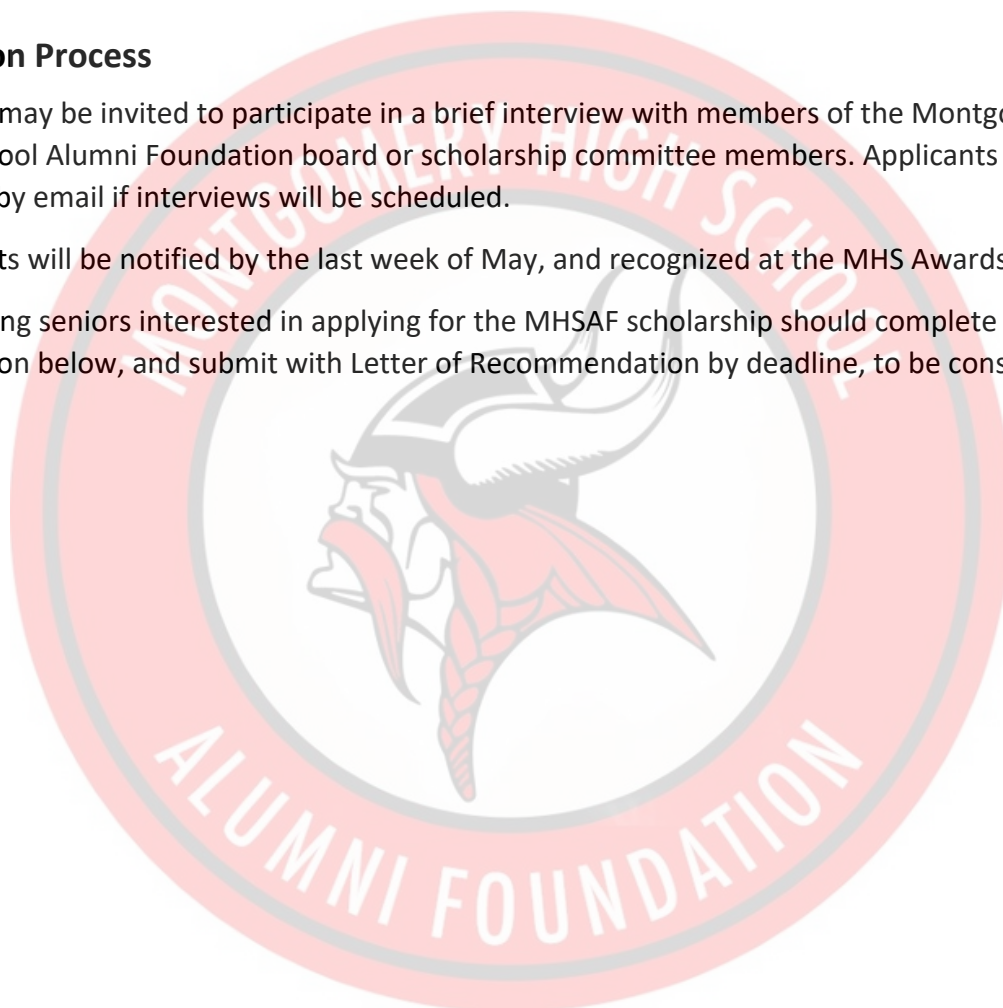
- Attended Montgomery High School for a minimum of two years.
- Letter of Recommendation: Submit one Letter of Recommendation from a Montgomery High School staff member with scholarship application.
- Completed "Scholarship Application" with Letter of Recommendation must be received by April 27, 2026. They may be emailed to MontgomeryAlumniFoundation@gmail.com or place in the MHS Alumni Foundation box in the main office.
- **Deadline: All documents must be received by April 27, 2026**

Selection Process

Finalists may be invited to participate in a brief interview with members of the Montgomery High School Alumni Foundation board or scholarship committee members. Applicants will be notified by email if interviews will be scheduled.

Recipients will be notified by the last week of May, and recognized at the MHS Awards Night.

Graduating seniors interested in applying for the MHSAF scholarship should complete the application below, and submit with Letter of Recommendation by deadline, to be considered.
